TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Validity

The pass is valid **only** for travel on a Shamrock Bus from home to school (and return) and can be used **only**:

- by the person named on the pass. **PASSES ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE**
- for travel using the service(s) shown on the pass
- during the period shown on the pass

Fraudulent use of a pass will lead to its confiscation.

Refunds

Refunds for all or part of the term of the pass cannot be given.

Before applying for a Shamrock Scholar's Pass we advise you to check your entitlement to a local authority pass. We regret we cannot give refunds if you subsequently decide you do not want the Shamrock Scholar's Pass. In some exceptional cases refunds will be made at Shamrock Buses' discretion and a £15 administration charge will be deducted.

Inspection

The pass must be produced on request by Shamrock Buses' drivers and inspectors. If a valid pass cannot be shown the fare will be required before travel is allowed.

Lost or Damaged Passes

A replacement pass will be issued by the Shamrock Buses office at a cost of £5.00.

Defaced or unreadable passes are invalid. Temporary passes cannot be issued and the fare will be required until a request and payment for a replacement pass is received.

Changes

If you move house or change school a new pass might be needed. Please contact Shamrock Buses immediately to check whether your pass is still valid.

Conduct of Passengers

Conduct of Passengers is regulated by law. Bad behaviour is not acceptable and could result in refusal of travel on the bus and your pass being withdrawn.
